

USGA RULES APPLY UNLESS MODIFIED BY

LOCAL RULES USED AT CHIPPEWA G.C.

- A ball striking an electric tower or elevated wire must be replayed.
- White circled areas are considered ground under repair.
- The player shall obtain relief not nearer the hole and drop within one club-length.
- **Rule 25-1b (I)**
- Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green at all times. **Rule 25-2**
- Play is prohibited from prepared areas (flowerbeds) – Drop one club length from the nearest point of relief - no penalty. **Rule 25-1b (I)**
- Out-of-Bounds – white stakes. **Definitions Section II**
- Water Hazards – yellow stakes. **Rule 26-1 a-c**
- Lateral Water Hazards – red stakes. **Rule 26-1 a-c**
- Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions and may be removed. **Rule 24-1**
- PLEASE REPAIR BALL MARKS AND REPLACE ALL DIVOTS. SAND BOTTLES ARE PROVIDED ON GOLF CARTS TO FILL AND SMOOTH TEE AND FAIRWAY DIVOTS.
- ALL BUNKERS MUST BE RAKED AND SMOOTHED OUT OF COURTESY TO FELLOW COMPETITORS.

Colored Fairway markers are measured to the center of all greens.

Red = 100 yards White = 150 yards Blue = 200 yards
